RESERVATIONS REQUIRED PLANNING YOUR RESERVATION

RESERVATIONS REQUIRED:

Use the Time Schedule to plan your field trip, e-mail us at education@mobileinternationalfestival.org with approximate numbers as soon as possible.

RESERVATION DEADLINE:

Reservation deadline is Monday, September 22, 2025.

Space is limited for each time session, so it is important to make your reservation as soon as possible, if needed adjustments can be made at the time of payment.

Due to space, only pre-registered groups will be admitted. Reservation and payment is required by October 6, 2025.

PAYMENT DEADLINE:

Payment deadline is Monday, October 13, 2025.

In the event of non-payment, MIF will give priority to groups on our waiting list.

GROUP STRUCTURE:

There should be **ONE** adult for every **TEN** students (Grades 6-12) and **ONE** adult for every **FIVE** students (Grades 3-5) attending the festival.

There must also be at least ONE LEAD TEACHER accompanying each school group.

CHAPERONES:

Chaperone makeup (as outlined above – adult numbers) will be strictly enforced! Chaperones may NOT be accompanied by young children or other family members.

ADMISSION for every teacher and chaperone accompanying the group must be purchased as part of the admission packet just like the students in the field trip group.



RESERVATIONS REQUIRED PLANNING YOUR RESERVATION, (CONT'D)

“WILL CALL” on school days is available ONLY for OUT OF MOBILE COUNTY school groups.

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Mobile International Festival School Day Rules and Guidelines

1. All students must wear one of the following forms of IDENTIFICATION: School Uniforms, T Shirts with School Name or Name Tags.
2. ARRIVAL/UNLOADING/ENTRANCE: Busses will arrive and park in the parking lot as directed by an attendant. Students, accompanied by a teacher, will enter at the front entrance of The Grounds, located 1035 Cody Road North.
3. DEPARTURE: Students and teachers will EXIT from the front of the building to the parking lot to return to school or to go on to another activity/tour.
4. As noted in the published schedule recommended departure times are listed and announcements will be made regarding departure times. LEAD TEACHERS in each group must pay attention to YOUR GROUP schedule and departure time. MAKE SURE ALL STUDENTS AND CHAPERONES HAVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR DEPARTURE TIME.
5. Lost Student Procedure – When planning your field trip, include a lost student protocol, inform them what to do if they get lost (go to a security guard or to the festival office at the front of The Grounds, do NOT leave the building). As you return to your buses and notice that you have a “lost student,” go to the nearest exit and inform security. We will then search for the student and have him or her meet at the exit. Do NOT have your groups spread out looking for your missing student. In the event you depart and realize there is a missing student, come to the main entrance and advise the security guards of your situation as it is likely that students will have been “found” by MIF or The Grounds staff and are waiting in the festival office for you. Students will NOT be allowed to depart The Grounds with anyone other than the lead teacher, chaperone or parent (who must show proper photo ID).
6. OUT of TOWN (non Mobile County) Schools with “will call” tickets will be able to pick-up on Student Days at The Grounds ticket office. We recommend picking up your packets prior to arrival as there may be a delay in your admission due to the congestion of arriving school groups, etc.
7. Teachers and chaperones attending must have an admission packet just like the students in all groups. No exceptions.
8. Students MUST remain inside The Grounds until their designated departure with the group.
9. Make sure students have additional money to be able to make purchases; additional food tokens will be available for purchase on student days at the food token booth.



Mobile International Festival School Day Rules and Guidelines, (Cont’)

10. FOOD TOKENS may NOT be used to make purchases at the cultural booths, only the FOOD booths will take these food tokens. Cultural booths accepting food tokens will be penalized if they take such tokens as payment. FOOD TOKENS are not refundable.
11. NO OUTSIDE FOOD or BAG LUNCHES! The purpose of MIF is to introduce students to cultures and foods from different countries. Menus at each booth will list food items and the number of tokens that must be used to pay for the food items.
12. FOOD ALLERGIES: Every effort will be made to list ingredients related to food allergies, if you have a student or adult with food allergies make sure you specifically ask first before purchasing foods. Always ASK even if there is a sign! Many countries use nuts, etc. in their food items. ASK, ASK!
13. High School students that travel in private cars must have their prepaid ticket to enter The Grounds.
14. Teachers and chaperones are responsible for the students adhering to their school systems “Student Code of Conduct” while in The Grounds.
15. Students who are NOT part of a school group or who arrive unescorted will not be admitted to student days.
16. For security reasons, MIF does not allow anyone who is not specifically associated with the school group into the festival on student days. This includes parents, grandparents or other family members (who are not teachers or designated chaperones with the group).
17. Location for “Lost & Found” is the Information Booth located in the front lobby. For lost articles during the festival, contact (The Grounds) 251-344-4573 or Denise Miner (MIF) 251-208-1556 within one month.
18. Absolutely, NO CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF SIX (6) will be allowed on Student Days for safety reasons. Teachers, please advise your students and parents/chaperones. Make sure ALL your Chaperones know this.
19. We ask that there be no strollers or backpacks in The Grounds, for security reasons.

By order of The Grounds and MIF, no weapons are allowed into the building on student days, see The Grounds guards if anyone has questions about this policy. Security is provided by the Mobile Police Department, The Grounds security, MIF Security and Coast Guard volunteers. All safety and security concerns must be reported to The Grounds and MIF staff.



CHAPERONE RULES AND GUIDELINES

Teachers: Please give a copy of this page and ALL the MIF rules to each Chaperone.

1. There must be one LEAD teacher for each group. All chaperones must follow the instructions of this lead teacher.
2. Chaperones are required for each group so that they may ensure that all students behave appropriately and follow the student conduct codes as well as MIF rules.
3. Chaperones may not bring underage children or children who are not part of the class group attending the student day.
4. Chaperones may not bring “friends” with them or have “friends” meet them on the student days
5. Chaperones must know the arrival and DEPARTURE times and plans. See the general MIF rules regarding departure.
6. Chaperones must have an admission ticket purchased through the group reservation, no chaperones will be admitted without a ticket, no tickets will be sold at The Grounds on student days.
7. Chaperones must be familiar with the lost student procedure (see lead teacher and MIF rules for instructions).
8. Each chaperone is assigned to a specific number of students. You are responsible for these students during the entire stay at the MIF and any other joint tours if applicable. Student behavior is your responsibility.
9. Make sure you know if any students in your group have a food allergy or other.
10. No Smoking, drugs, alcohol or weapons are allowed on The Grounds property at any time during the student days.
11. Absolutely, NO CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF SIX (6) will be allowed on Student Days for safety reasons. Teachers, please advise your students and parents/chaperones. Make sure ALL your Chaperones know this.
12. We ask that there be no strollers or backpacks in The Grounds.

Parent/Guardian Information

The Mobile International Festival is held each year as a non-profit (501c3) educational and cultural event for schools and families to enrich the education process. The goals of the festival are to:

1. Provide a strong active learning environment for schools and teachers to use as a field trip activity that enhances and adds to their classroom work. This learning environment includes opportunities to integrate a wide range of academic activities from geography and history to language and the sciences.
2. Provide a broad multi cultural view of the heritage of Mobile, Alabama and the United States. With over 70 cultural booths and 30 food booths, each representing a country or region of the world, students will get to meet the many different Mobile residents whose heritage is tied to these areas of the world.
3. Provide students and school groups with an active environment that includes hands-on art and educational activities (scavenger hunt, worksheets, etc.) as well as a series of stage areas where they can hear and participate in dance, music and activities such as storytelling.

The festival is sponsored each year by the City and County of Mobile as well as many sponsors <http://www.mobileinternationalfestival.org> that help keep the costs to the schools reasonable and with access to more educational activities than is available anywhere else. MIF admission for school groups on student days is \$10 (\$5.00 ticket plus a \$5.00 food token packet). Schools can also elect to ADD an additional \$5.00 food token packet onto this cost as well so students do not have to carry as much money with them on the day of the event. Food tokens CANNOT be used for cultural booth purchases. Food prices range from as little as two tokens to four or five tokens (each food token packet has ten tokens in a bundle). Additional tokens can be purchased on the day of the event. The value of each token is \$.50 and is non refundable.

Schools typically must add to this cost expenses for buses, drivers, and any other activities to be included in the field trip thus the total field trip cost may be higher yet very reasonable.
